# Freehold Country Residence

very substantially erected in the Tudor style, with hollow exterior walls, mullioned windows, panelled oak shutters, and ornamental chimneys.

### Entrance Porch

with pair large studded doors with stone flagged floor.

### Entrance Hall

with pair glazed oak doors, stone flagged floor, hot water radiator encased by oak grille, pair inner oak doors with finely carved side panels.

### Morning Room

20-ft. 6-ins. by 19-ft. with brick fireplace, stone hearth and kerb, hot water radiator encased by oak grille and oak floor.

### Lounge

25-ft. into bay by 19-ft. extremes with stove, 2 hot water radiators encased by oak grilles, pair casement doors to garden and oak floor.

### Dining Room

22-ft. by 16-ft. 3-in. extremes with dog grate, handsomely carved mantelpiece and overmantel, 2 ribbon panelled doors, moulded ceiling and hot water radiator encased by oak grille.

### Study

with stove, stone hearth and kerb, carved mantel, hot water radiator and bookcase with adjustable shelves as fitted in recess.
