Thrashing M.F. 87 1933/4 crop



<u>Cottage at Whitwell</u>: formerly occupied by Mrs. Chipperfield. Condemned and unoccupied for 4 years. Roof timbers (oak) found to be good except for 2 rafters. Completely re-conditioned May 1934 and made habitable at a labour cost, including supervision of £27. 5. 0., exclusive of thatching.
