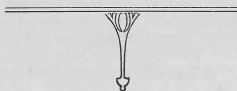

It is quite obvious the Adjudicator can only pass judgment upon what he hears. Please remember that, **and let him hear.** Limit your conversation and moving from one part of the Hall to another to the intervals between the playing of bands. Give to each band that same sporting chance to let their rendition of the test piece reach the judge quite clearly and easily, that you would expect and hope to get if you were actually on the stage yourself.

Think it over and no crescendo in that buzz of conversation, *pp* all the way please.
