Agreement between
Reepham Bandsmen

Memorandum of An Agreement made this thirtyfirst day of May in the year nineteen hundred and thirtyfive between all the undersigned, being members of Reepham Town Temperance Band whereby we mutually agree as follows:-

(1) That we hereby become a uniform committee for the purpose of entering into an Hire Purchase Agreement with Messrs. Bossey and Stawkes Ltd of 295 Regent St. London for the purchase of twenty sets of uniform at a total cost of twentyfour pounds fifteen shillings & sixpence, such uniform to become the absolute property of the above named Band at the conclusion of the said Hire Purchase Agreement.

(2) That we, the undersigned, hereby agree to become solely and legally responsible for the payment of the above named sum by means of a deposit and monthly payments to Messrs Bossey & Stawkes Ltd

(3) That in the event of any of the undersigned failing to discharge his portion of the liability such sum as he has already paid shall be forfeited to the Uniform Fund and he shall become immediately liable for the Balance of his portion namely £4. 12. -.

(4) That the liability of each man is a maximum of four pounds twelve shillings which he agrees to discharge as follows:-

(a) By a cash payment at this date in which case all further liability to payment will cease.

(b) By monthly payments spread over six months, to total (with any deposit paid at this date) the sum of £4. 12. 0 in which case the liability shall continue

until the said sum has been paid or
the Stie Purchase Agreement terminated
whichever is the earlier.

It is expressly agreed and understood
that nothing foregoing in this clause
shall prejudice the liability of all the
undersigned should the forfeiture clauses
of the Stie Purchase Agreement become
enforceable.

(5) That when the Band shall
commence to repay the Bandsmen for the
uniforms above purchased such payments
shall first accrue to those who paid
in a lump sum and, after this has been
discharged, to those who have paid in
instalments. In each case the sum paid
by the Band to be equally divided amongst
those concerned.
