

## THE LATE MR. STANLEY WATSON

### FUNERAL AT REEPHAM.

The funeral service of the late Mr. Stanley Watson took place in Hackford and Whitwell St. Michael and All Angels' Church on Tuesday. His death took place on Sunday, following an injury he received on Friday. He was only 36 years of age and had been employed for upwards of 20 years by Edward Gibbs & Son, iron-mongers and seedsmen, of Reepham. Of a jovial and happy disposition, he was actively associated with the Reepham Cricket Club, the Reepham Sun Bowls Club, and the old Reepham Athletic Football Club. He served in the Great War and was a member of the Reepham branch of the British Legion, members of which lined the pathway to the church door.
