
## GB/REE/1905071255 Reepham Town Band Agreement



AN AGREEMENT made this 20th day of June 1935 between the undersigned members of REEPHAM TOWN TEMPERANCE BAND(hereinaftercalled the Bandsmen) and the Committee of the same Band(hereinafter called the Band) WHEREBY it is agreed as follows:-

- Each of the undersigned Bandsmen undertakes to purchase a complete set of UNIFORM from Messrs BOOSEY and Hawkes Ltd., of 295 Regent Street London., to the value of Four pounds Twelve Shillings such Uniform to become the absolute property of the Band Trustees at completion of purchase.
- 2. In consideration therof the Band herby undertakes to repay to the Bandsmen in instalments as and when funds become available for this pupose by special efforts etc.,(always providing that such special efforts are not part of the Bands ordinary and usual activities) the total sum he has paid into the uniform Funds less a sum of 10/(Ten shillings) which will remain in the Bands general funds as adeposit by the Bandsmen against the safe return of the Uniform to the Band in good condition, fair wear and tear excepted) should he leave the Band for any valid reason and to be forfeited should the Bandsmen be expelled for a breach of the Rules or leave the Band without a satisfactory reason or return the Uniform in a damaged condition. It is also expressly agreed that the decision of the Band Committee in office at the time shall be final and legally binding for all the puposes of this clause.
- 3. Furthermore should any Bandsman absent himself from any effort agreed on by the remainder of the Band for the Uniform funds without the consent of the other Bandsman he agrees to forfeit an amount equal to the share of each attending Bandsman to the Band Funds such amount to be deducted from the amout due from the Band to him(if any)or otherwise paid to the Funds by the defaulting Bandsman.
