I devise all my real estate in London or such part thereof
as shall be unsold at the time of my death unto my two
daughters Maud Frances Umfreville Wilkinson and
Geraldine Marlow Wilkinson in equal shares as tenants in
common And lastly I devise and bequeath all my
real and personal estate except what I otherwise dispose of
by this my Will or any Codicil hereto unto my three daughters

Wilkinson Executrices of this my Will In witness
